## PROGRAM REPORTS

The **NCLEX<sup>®</sup> Program Reports** are invaluable reports that contain more than 25 different tables and charts that document how the performance of graduates from a particular nursing program compares to the performance of graduates from other programs in the same jurisdiction or regulatory body and nationwide. These reports can be downloaded in an electronic format quickly and easily.

Through the NCLEX Program Reports, you can learn how your program's graduates performed overall and in each of the eight areas of the NCLEX Test Plan. In addition, the performance of your graduates is reported within the categories of each of the following frameworks:

- Four (PN) – five (RN) phases of the Nursing Process;
- Eight categories of Human Functioning;
- Ten categories of Health Alterations;
- Four areas of the Wellness/Illness Continuum;
- Six stages of Maturity; and
- Four aspects of Stress, Adaptation and Coping.

## SUPPLEMENTAL CSV FILES AVAILABLE

You can supplement your NCLEX Program Reports subscription with a corresponding set of Supplemental CSV files which enable you to open your NCLEX Program Reports data in many spreadsheet applications, such as Microsoft Excel, or data analysis tools such as SPSS. The CSV files contain the exact same values that are contained in your NCLEX Program Reports

subscription. Using these files, you can easily track your program's performance longitudinally (over time) or make comparisons between the performance of graduates in two different educational programs within your organization.

## SUBSCRIPTION DETAILS

The NCLEX Program Reports are provided as an online subscription service. Seven different editions of the NCLEX Program Reports are published each year (four quarterly, two semi-annual and one annual). Report editions are published four times a year (May, August, November and February).

Each report is created using the data from the NCLEX candidates testing during a specific timeframe called the reporting period. Programs should only order reports for reporting periods in which they expect at least 10 students to complete the NCLEX Examination.
