- NCLEX-RN Activity Statements
  - Added activity statements:
    - Psychosocial Integrity
      - Provide care for a client experiencing grief or loss
    - Pharmacological and Parenteral Therapies
      - Handle and/or administer high-risk medications
    - Reduction of Risk Potential
      - Manage client during a procedure with moderate sedation
    - Reduction of Risk potential
      - Maintain percutaneous feeding tube
  - Transferred Activity Statements:
    - Moved from Management of Care to Safety and Infection Control
      - Report unsafe practice of health care personnel and intervene as appropriate (e.g., substance abuse, improper care, staffing practices)
    - Moved from Basic Care and Comfort to Reduction of Risk Potential
      - Apply and/or maintain devices used to promote venous return (e.g., anti-embolic stockings, sequential compression devices)
