# NCSBN Leadership and Public Policy Conference

The registration fee for the conference is \$350 per person. The registration fee for NCSBN member is \$250 per member representative (NCSBN members are staff or board members of U.S. nursing regulatory bodies, exam user members and associate members).

Registration includes all sessions, dinner, continental breakfasts, lunches, refreshment breaks, Kennedy Space Center and meeting materials.

The registration deadline is Oct. 12, 2022. The capacity for the conference is 100 attendees and is on a firstcome, first-served basis. Online registration will stop once capacity is reached; a wait list will then be started.

#### **Airport: Arrival**

#### Jacksonville International Airport (JAX):

Plan on approximately 1 hour in travel time from the airport to the hotel depending on arrival time.

Plan on approximately 1 hour travel time from the Kennedy Space Center to the airport.

#### Taxi

Taxi service is available via the taxi pickupstation on the Lower Level outside Baggage Claim. No reservations are required for arriving passengers. A one-way fare to St. Augustine Beach is approximately \$95–125 and takes about one hour.

#### Rideshare

Lyft/Uber are authorized to provide pick-up services at JAX. Passengers can make a request once they are located on the terminal curbside. The airport fee applies to pick-ups only. Signs that state "App-Based Rides Service" are positioned on the Lower Arrival Curb outside Baggage Claim Door 3 and to the right. Always confirm that you are getting in the correct vehicle with the designated driver shown on the app.

Instructions regarding the proof of fully vaccinated status that will be accepted and how to submit that information for review will be provided prior to the start of the meeting.

Individuals who are not fully vaccinated one day prior to an NCSBN in-person meeting or conference, or who have not by that date submitted appropriate proof of their fully vaccinated status as required, will be not be permitted to attend in-person.
