

Timeline for the Implementation of the 2019 NCLEX-RN® Test Plan

August 2018	Delegate Assembly action is provided
September 2018	Panel of Judges meet to recommend the 2019 NCLEX-RN® Passing Standard
December 2018	NCSBN Board of Directors evaluates the 2019 NCLEX-RN Passing Standard
January 2019	The approved 2019 NCLEX-RN Test Plan is published and placed on the NCSBN website
April 1, 2019	Approved 2019 NCLEX-RN Test Plan and the 2019 NCLEX-RN Passing Standard are effective



- Continue to monitor all administrative, test development and psychometric aspects of the NCLEX® program.
- Evaluate all aspects of the NCLEX program and initiate additional quality assurance processes as needed.
- Evaluate NCLEX informational initiatives, such as the NCLEX conferences, NCLEX Regional Workshops and other presentations.
- Communicate updates regarding the Next Generation NCLEX project including research outcomes, as well as implications for students, educators, regulators and health care organizations.

- Evaluate ongoing international testing
- Host the 2018 NCLEX® Conference
- Introduce additional alternate format item types
- Explore additional item writing strategies for the NCLEX
- Conduct NCLEX-RN® Standard Setting
