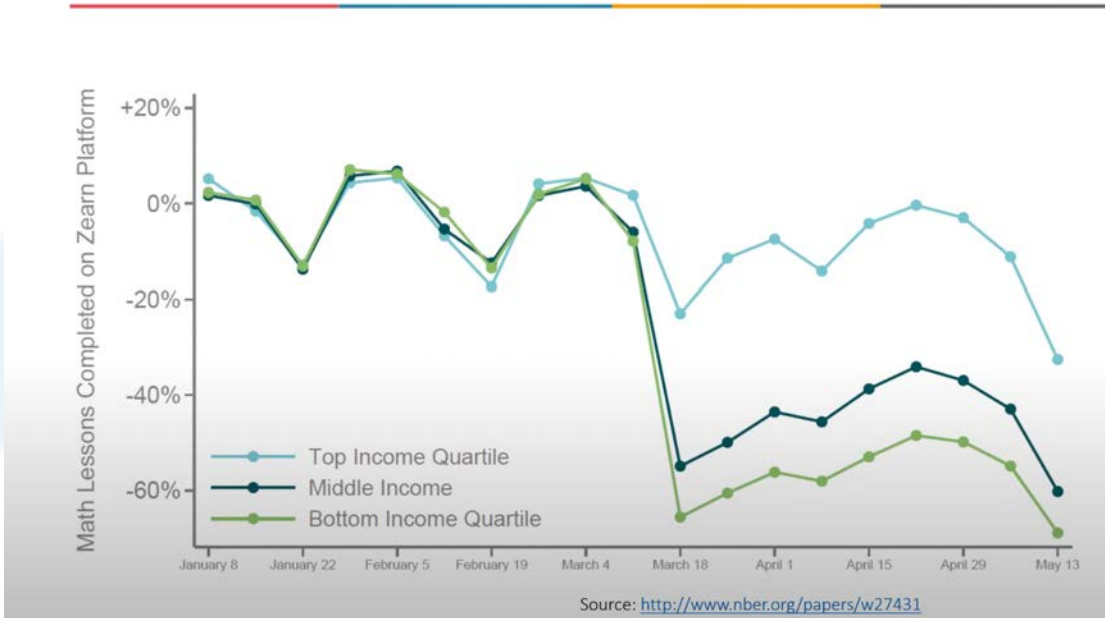

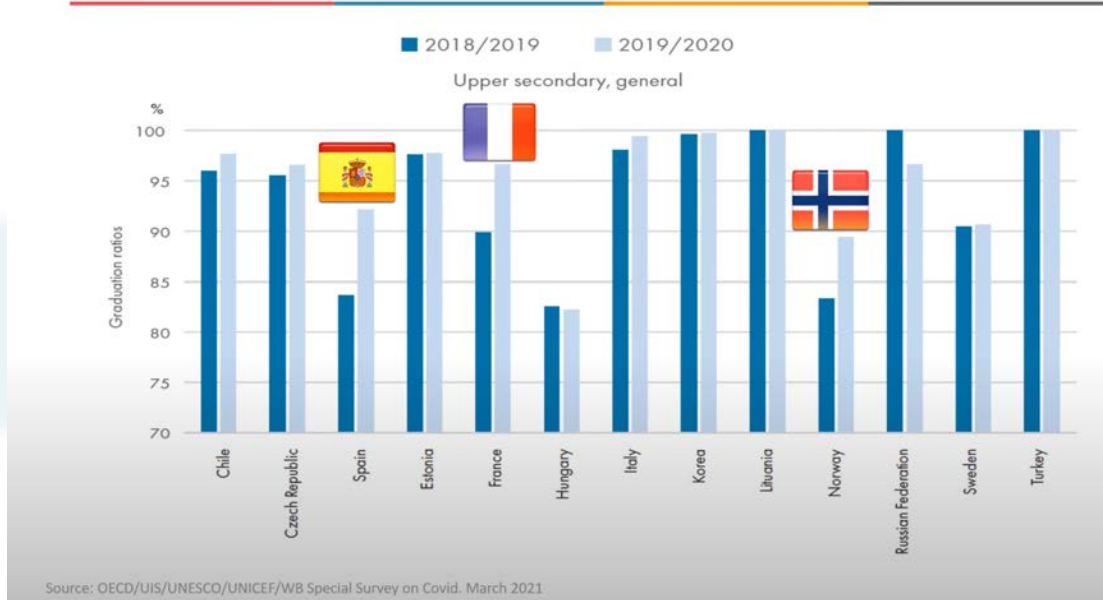

Learning loss in hybrid teaching & learning mode (2020)



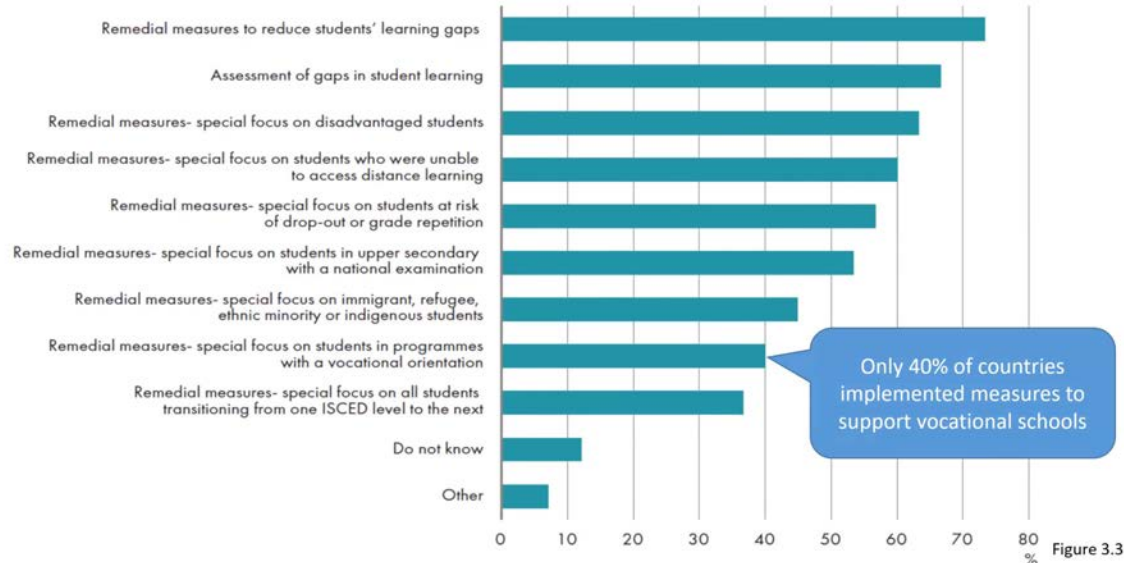
Things to Consider
