





### **Practice Analysis Overview**

	Practice analysis	<ul> <li>Gather information about duties and responsibilities of a particular job.</li> <li>Data collected can be used in various settings.</li> </ul>
	REx-PN®	<ul> <li>Performed every 5 years</li> <li>Panel of nurse experts convenes.</li> <li>Results guide the REx- PN Test Plan.</li> </ul>
	Subject Matter	<ul> <li>Various nursing backgrounds and representations.</li> </ul>
	Experts (SMEs)	<ul> <li>Resources provided on entry-level nursing.</li> <li>Meeting outcomes.</li> </ul>



# **Example of REx-PN® Activity Statements**

**Management of Care** 

Delegate and supervise care of client provided by others (e.g., unregulated care providers)

Integrate advance directives into client care plan

Prioritize the delivery of client care

#### **Basic Care and Comfort**

Perform irrigations (e.g., bladder, wound, eye)

Provide non-pharmacological comfort measures



## **2019 Entry Competencies and Practice Analysis Mapping**




### LPN/RPN Demographics from 2019 Practice Analysis

### **Education Programs**






### Months Since Graduation and Employment






### **Client Health Conditions**





### Test Plan Category #1: Management of Care

Provides and directs nursing care that enhances the care and delivery setting to protect clients and health care personnel





- Delegate and supervise care of client provided by others (e.g., unregulated care providers)
- Organize workload to manage time effectively
- Maintain client confidentiality and privacy
- Prioritize the delivery of client care



### Test Plan Category #2 Safety and Infection Control

Protects clients and health care personnel from health and environmental hazards




- Ensure proper identification of client when providing care
- Safely and appropriately use equipment
- Educate client and staff regarding infection control measures
- Follow policies and procedures for use of restraints



### **Test Plan Category #3 Health Promotion and Maintenance**

Provides and directs nursing care of the client that incorporates the knowledge of expected growth and development principles; prevention and early detection of health problems, and strategies to achieve optimal health




- Identify barriers to communication
- Assess client about determinants of • health and implement interventions
- Plan and/or participate in health care activities for clients in community setting



### **Test Plan Category #4 Psychosocial Integrity**


Provides and directs nursing care that promotes and supports the emotional, mental and social wellbeing of the client experiencing stressful events, as well as clients with acute or chronic mental illness



- Provide end-of-life care to clients
- Assess family dynamics to determine • care plan
- Provide care of the cognitively impaired ٠ client
- Use therapeutic communication • techniques

### Test Plan Category #5 Basic Care and Comfort

# *Provides comfort and assistance in the performance of activities of daily living*




- Provide non-pharmacological comfort measures
- Assess client for pain and intervene
- Monitor the client's nutritional status
- Assess and maintain site care for client with enteral tubes



### Test Plan Category #6 Pharmacological and Parenteral Therapies

Provides care related to the administration of medications and parenteral therapies




- Evaluate client response to medication
- Educate client about medications
- Participate in medication reconciliation process
- Handle and maintain medication in a safe and controlled environment



### Test Plan Category #7 Reduction of Risk Potential

Reduces the likelihood that clients will develop complications or health problems related to existing conditions, treatments or procedures 11%




- Assess and respond to changes and/or trends in client vital signs
- Monitor the results of diagnostic testing and intervene
- Perform focused assessments
- Educate client about treatments and procedures



### Test Plan Category #8 Physiological Adaptation

Manages and provides care for clients with acute, chronic or life-threatening physical health conditions



- Provide postoperative care
- Manage the care of the client with a fluid and electrolyte imbalance
- Educate client regarding an acute or chronic condition
