





# **REx-PN<sup>®</sup> Cycle**



# **Practice Analysis**

- Often referred to as a job analysis
- Analyze the on-the-job behaviors of the incumbent nurses
- Results used to develop the exam outline or REx-PN® Test Plan


## **REx-PN<sup>®</sup> Test Plan**

- Content Distribution
- REx-PN Integrated Processes
- Administration
- Nursing content examples
- REx-PN Item after each test plan category
- Computerized Adaptive Test (CAT) principles



## **REx-PN<sup>®</sup> Test Plan**

- Developed as a result of the recent practice analysis data
- Used to guide REx-PN content delivery during each exam
- Serves as a guide for candidates





# **Item Development**

- Item Writing
- Item Review
- Sensitivity Review
- Differential Item Functioning (DIF) Review
- Nursing Regulatory Body (NRB) Review



# **Item Development - Roles**



#### **Item Writers**

Create the questions or "items" that are used on the REx-PN®



#### **Item Reviewers**

Examine the items that are created by Item
Writers



# **Item Development - Item Writers**

Requirements

- Current, unencumbered RN or RPN/PN nursing license in British Columbia or Ontario
- Current employment position of faculty teaching PN nursing content in the clinical area



## **REx-PN<sup>®</sup> Items Must Be**

Linked to the test plan

Suitable for entrylevel practice

Accurate

Current in nursing practice

Only one correct answer

Unless multiple response



# **Item Development – Item Reviewers**

Requirements

- Current, unencumbered RN or RPN/PN nursing license in British Columbia or Ontario
- Maintain knowledge regarding current PN practice, including entry-level PN practice
- Current employment consists of providing direct client care in a clinical setting and working with PN entry-level nurses greater than 8 hours per week **OR**
- Current employment as a clinical instructor



#### **Unintentional Bias Reviews**

- Sensitivity Review
  - Pretest
- DIF Review
  - Pretest
  - Operational



#### Unintentional Bias Review Criteria

Stereotypes

Inflammatory material

Language

Assumptions



#### **Unintentional Bias Reviews**

- All items are reviewed to ensure the exclusion of sensitive, unintentional biased language
- Items are edited to remove words or phrases which may affect exam measurement



## **Editorial Review**







Clarity



Punctuation



Spelling



One Writer



#### **Pretest Items**

- Every item is pretested before being placed in the operational pool
- Statistical data are gathered on each pretested item
- Data are used to evaluate items and ensure all operational items are accurate and fit the testing model
- 30 pretest items on every REx-PN® exam



## Pretest Items (continued)

- Randomly intermixed with operational items
- Not used to estimate the candidate's ability
- Used for maintaining item bank inventory
- Indistinguishable from operational items for candidates



#### **NRB Review**

- Conducted biannually
- Review criteria
  - Entry-Level appropriateness
  - Congruency in nurse administrative rules and regulations
  - Comments forwarded to REx-PN® Practical Nurse Examination Committee (PNEC)



#### **PNEC Review**

- Comprised of nurse regulators in various jurisdictions
- Establishes and maintains REx-PN® policies
- Provides item disposition

Pool Rotation and Maintenance



**Item Review** 



**Content Currency** 



#### **Pool Rotation**

- REx-PN® item pool delivery schedule
- Review activities prior to pool deployment



#### **Item Review and Maintenance**



REx-PN® review is cyclical and ongoing



Occurs at each segment of item development process



Items are reviewed with each operational pool deployment



All other items reviewed at least every four years



#### **Identification of Outdated Content**

- Validation Process
  - Staff Reviews (referencing)
- Item Review Panels
  - Subject Matter Experts (SMEs)
  - NRB Reviews



## **Changes that Trigger Pool Reviews**



Healthcare guidelines

Heart and Stroke Foundation of
Canada



Medication/Device Recall or Discontinuation



**Public Policy** 

Car Seat Guidelines Medication Disposal

# **Examples**

Outdated	Current
CPR Guidelines: Airway, Breathing, Compressions (ABC)	Compressions, Airway, Breathing (CAB)
Munchausen Syndrome Munchausen by proxy	Factitious Disorder Factitious Disorder imposed on another
Juvenile diabetes mellitus	Diabetes Mellitus (type 1)
Pressure ulcer	Pressure injury



#### **Corrective Actions**



outdated content
