The Power of a Strategy Statement


A strategy statement is an internal document that bridges elements of mission and vision to a clear plan for action.

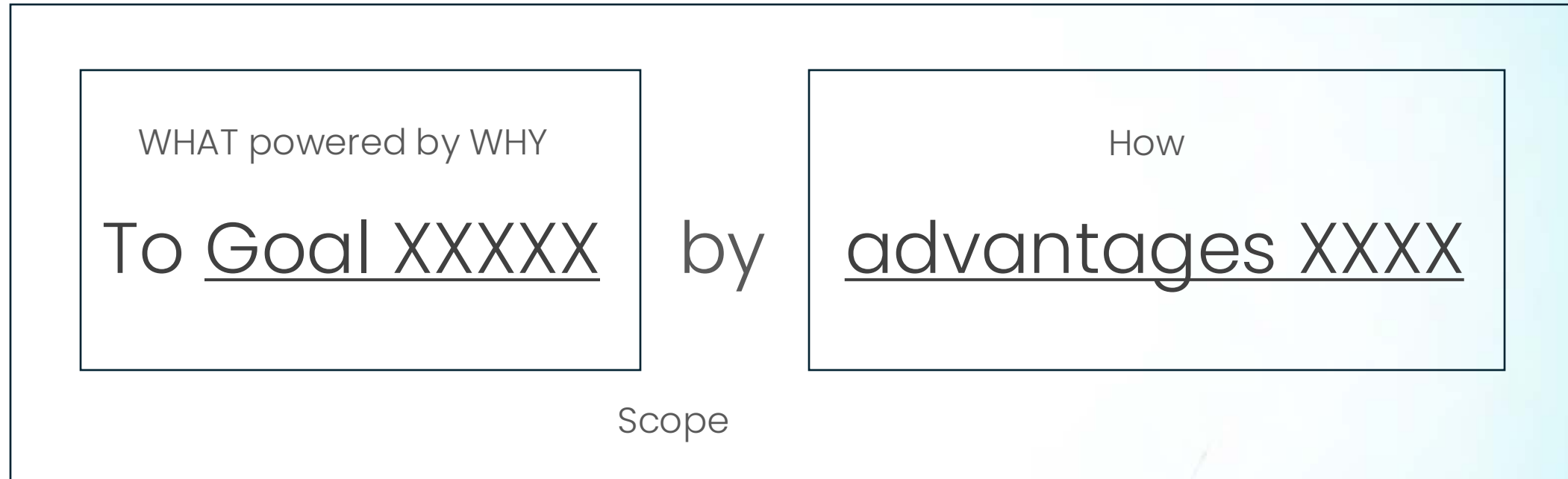

Strategy Statement Breakdown

"To protect the public and the trust in nursing by providing innovative regulatory solutions, insights and expertise."

This statement:

- **Sets objective** (public protection, moments of nursing)
- **Defines scope** (nursing, regulatory, innovation)
- **States advantages** (solutions, insights, expertise)
- Has an emotional component (words like protect and trust)
- Guides decision making (what we do should fit within those three categories with the right improvement-based mindset)
- Is simple, clear, memorable and actionable
- Works for internal and external audiences
- Drives excellence and improvement (innovative)
- Balances comprehensiveness with brevity (hits sweet spot of 15-30 words without missing detail and uses every word efficiently)

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
