- Approved NCLEX items used in exam scoring

# FY25 NEC Accomplishments (cont.)

- Published the 2024 RN Practice Analysis and 2024 RN Nursing Knowledge Survey reports
- Published the 2024 LPN/VN Practice Analysis and 2024 LPN/VN Nursing Knowledge Survey reports

### FY25 NEC Accomplishments (cont.)

- Reviewed and approved the 2025 NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN standard setting panel of judges
- Approved the 2026 NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN test plans for proposed recommendation to the Delegate Assembly

### Purpose of Practice Analysis Studies

- Periodically perform practice analyses to assist in evaluating the validity of the test plan and content distribution for NCLEX
- Provide a list of NEC-approved entry-level activity statements

  - 2024 RN Practice Analysis
  - 2024 LPN/VN Practice Analysis
  - Panelist expert judgment
  - Feedback from member boards and regulatory bodies

### NCLEX Test Plan Journey

- 2024 NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN practice analyses data analyzed
- NEC recommends a draft NCLEX test plan
  - Category structure
    - Client categories
    - Integrated processes
  - Category percentages
  - Content included (approved activity statements)
- Nursing regulatory body feedback
- Board of Directors
- Delegate Assembly

July 2025	Panel of Judges meets to recommend the 2026 NCLEX-RN passing standard
August 2025	Proposed 2026 NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN test plans submitted to the Delegate Assembly and action is provided
September 2025	Panel of Judges meets to recommend the 2026 NCLEX-PN passing standard
December 2025	<ul> <li>NCSBN Board of Directors evaluates the 2026 NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN passing standards</li> <li>The approved 2026 NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN test plans are published and placed on the NCLEX website</li> </ul>
April 1, 2026	Approved 2026 NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN test plans and 2026 NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN passing standards are effective



### **Future Activities**

- Continue to monitor all administrative, test development, and psychometric aspects of the NCLEX program
- Evaluate all aspects of the NCLEX program and initiate additional quality assurance processes as needed
- Evaluate NCLEX informational initiatives, such as the NCLEX conferences, NCLEX regional workshops, and other presentations



### Future Activities (cont.)

- Host the 2025 NCLEX Conference on September 10, 2025
- Conduct 2026 NCLEX-PN standard setting
- Communicate to disseminate original and collaborative research outcomes at professional and academic conferences

### Future Activities (cont.)

- Explore future uses of the NCSBN Clinical Judgment Measurement Model to better support efforts of nursing regulation
- Continue to develop and test remote proctoring using AI security technology
