The National Council of State Boards of Nursing is committed to establishing itself as a clearinghouse of information on the activities of its sixty Member Boards of Nursing. This publication is an initial step in the development of capabilities designed to be increasingly responsive to the information needs of the National Council's Member Boards and the public whom they protect through the regulation of nursing practice at the state level.

Provided in this initial publication are 1983 and 1984 statistics on the licensing activities of the National Council's Member Boards and on the National Council's two licensure examinations, the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN) and the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN). These examinations are each administered twice a year by Member Boards to test the entry-level capabilities of candidates for nurse licensure.

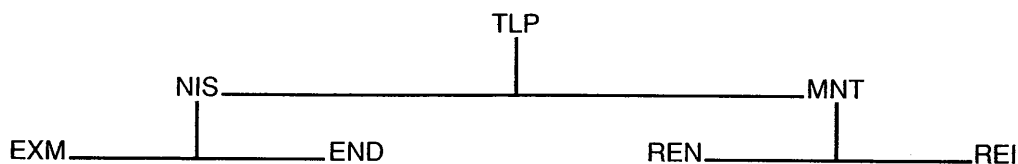
Licensure Statistics

Licensure statistics for the years 1983 and 1984 have been collected by the National Council from participating Member Boards of Nursing. Given the purpose of the National Council, the focus of this collection of statistics is understandably the Member Boards of Nursing themselves. Data are collected and organized to reflect the kind and volume of processing activities Member Boards of Nursing must perform in carrying out their responsibilities in licensing the practice of nursing.

As is indicated by the chart below, the total number of licenses processed by a Member Board in a given year, or TOTAL LICENSES PROCESSED (TLP), have been conceptually divided into two areas: NEW IN STATE (NIS) functions and MAINTENANCE (MNT) functions.

NEW IN STATE functions are those that bring nurses into a Member Board's jurisdiction. Nurses can be newly licensed in a state by passing the licensure EXAMINATION (EXM) administered by the Member Board, which is NCLEX-RN or NCLEX-PN, or through the ENDORSEMENT (END) of another jurisdiction's action that authorized a nurse to practice and issued a license to that nurse.

There are two other functions performed by Member Boards related to the MAINTENANCE of licenses. Each Member Board requires the RENEWAL (REN) of all nursing licenses at specific intervals, which differ from jurisdiction to jurisdiction. Each jurisdiction also allows for the REINSTATEMENT (REI) of a nurse's license to practice following disciplinary action or an extended time period when a nurse has not practiced and has let her license lapse.

By classifying the common licensure activities of the Member Boards in this manner, this collection of licensure statistics not only serves nursing as a whole by providing traditional licensure information, but also serves the National Council's Member Boards as a firm statistical basis for analyses into other areas of the Member Boards' responsibilities, including board structure, staffing, finances, and the services they provide the public to whom they are responsible.

Statistics concerning three other nursing licensure areas are presented in this publication. The numbers of graduates of foreign nursing programs licensed to practice in Member Board jurisdictions is provided in Table VIII for each year.

Table IX through Table XI and Table XIII provide a look at nursing specialties, which are defined to include those nurses who have been licensed or provided certificates to practice advanced nursing by participating Member Boards. Table XII gives a measure of the supply of nurses, as defined through licensure, of both registered nurses and practical nurses in the participating jurisdictions.

Examination Statistics

Except for one broad difference, the 1983 and 1984 examination statistics published here are the same set of data provided to the National Council and its Member Boards of Nursing by CTB/McGraw-Hill, the National Council's test service, following each administration of NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN.

NCLEX-RN and NCLEX-PN are each administered to licensure candidates by the National Council's Member Boards of Nursing two times every year. As is indicated at the top of the following charts, each administration of NCLEX-RN is called a series and is labeled with the month and the year it was administered: 283 for February and 783 for July 1983. Administrations of NCLEX-PN are called forms, and the same numbering system applies: 483 for April and 083 for October 1983.

Examination scores throughout these tables are scale scores. The passing scale score for NCLEX-RN is 1600. The passing scale score for NCLEX-PN is 350.

The single broad difference between the 1983 and 1984 examination statistics arises out of a resolution passed by the National Council's Delegate Assembly in 1983 that eliminated the confidential code by which individual state statistics had been identified in all previous years. Beginning in 1984, individual state statistics were identified by state, so some tables of individual state statistics provided here for 1984 are not provided for 1983.

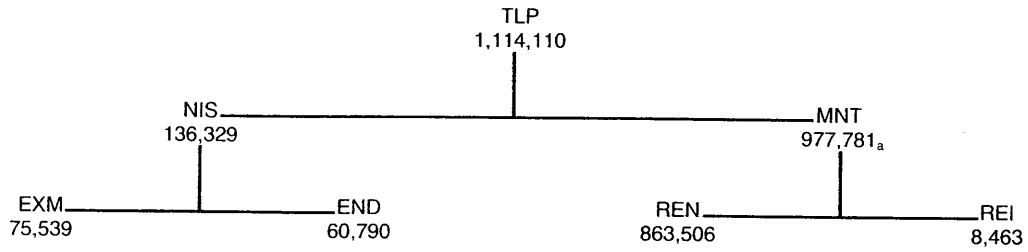

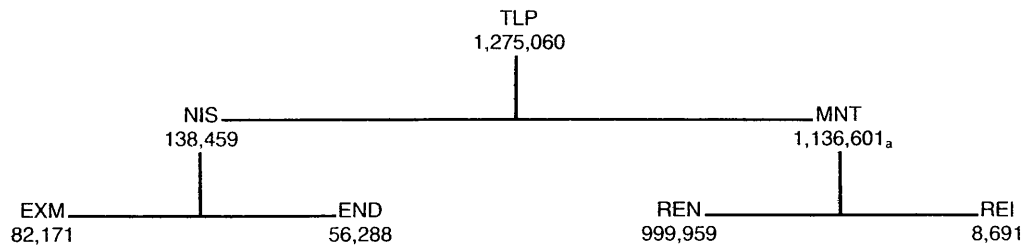

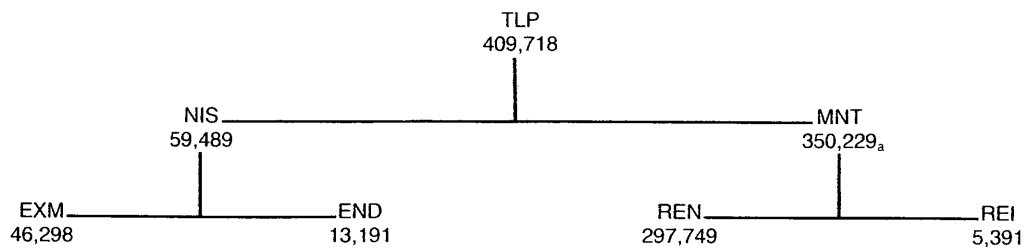
